Introduction

All Saints' Trust expects the highest standards of behaviour from all of our students, all of the time.

Therefore, our Mission Statement (building a stronger community together, united by our love of God) is at the centre of all that we do, so that students' behaviour reflects the Gospel values.

Local Protocol

Each school will publish on its website, their own individual school behaviour policy based on the following guiding principles.

Guiding Principles

- Pupils are expected to exercise self-discipline at all times.
- Pupils should have proper regard for authority and treat everyone in the school community with courtesy and respect.
- Staff, pupils and parents should work together to ensure that there are high standards of behaviour in the school.
- The curriculum offered in each school should encourage positive behaviour by ensuring that it engages students and caters for their individual needs.
- Staff should set high standards and have consistently high expectation in relation to pupil behaviour.
- Pupils must be respected and their views listened to.
- There should be a balance between rewards and sanctions in each school's behaviour policy.
- All schools must adhere to DfE guidance in respect of suspensions and permanent exclusions. Suspensions in each school are monitored by the Trust Board.
- Bullying of any kind will not be tolerated.

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
